- Gives facts and information about a topic
- Include text features such as headings, photos and captions, diagrams, maps, and time lines.

Comprehension Strategy: Ask and Answer Questions

- Ask questions when there are parts of a story you do not understand.

Comprehension Skill: Main Idea and Key Details

- The main idea is the most important idea that the author presents in a text or section of text.
- Key details give important information to support the main idea.

Vocabulary Strategy: Proverbs and Adages

- Proverbs and adages are short sayings or expressions that have been used for a long time and express a general truth.

- A preposition shows the relationship between a noun or a pronoun and another word in a sentence.
